

SPEC SHEET

ASAP JUMBO

Neck: Laminate of quartersawn mahogany and flamed maple, scarf jointed at the headstock and glued into the body. The headstock is faced with Rio rosewood.

Fingerboard: Selected ebony, bound with walnut sapwood and micarta nut. Scale length is 650mm. 45mm at nut

Machines: Schaller Vintage, chrome.

Frets: 20 Van Gent medium high, medium width, hard nickel silver.

Top: Bookmatched pink cedar, hand graduated and tap tuned. Bound in walnut sapwood and mulitply veneers. Bracing is of scalloped quartersawn spruce.

Back and Sides: Bookmatched birdseye maple. Bound in walnut sapwood. Back bracing is quartersawn mahogany.

Bridge: Custom made Rio rosewood, rosewood bridge pins, with compensated micarta saddle.

Finish: More than 20 coats of hand rubbed 2 pack, high gloss AC lacquer, a little ageing toner.

Strings: Newtone Masterclass 13-56

Pickup: EMF Core 99.

Switching: None

Circuitry: EMF Core 99 preamp.

Comments: All woods specially selected for tonal quality and appearance. This guitar is not designed for strings stronger than 13 guage. The battery for the preamp is fitted to the neck block. To ensure maximum battery life unplug the output cable when not in use.

Climatic Conditions and Guitars. This guitar was built at a relative humidity of 47% and under controlled temperature conditions. Fine guitars made from thin sheets of solid tone woods are affected by changes in humidity and major changes may cause damage. Do not subject this instrument to very dry (under 40%) or moist conditions (over 70%) or to rapid changes of temperature. Any damage caused to the instrument from being exposed to high or low humidity and/or from exposure to adverse temperature conditions will be the responsibility of the owner not the maker.
