



SPEC SHEET

ARCTOP MANDOLIN Serial no.960401

Neck: Laminate of quartersawn rock maple, flamed maple and mahogany, scarf jointed at the headstock and glued into the body. The headstock is faced with figured walnut.

Fingerboard: Selected quartersawn Indian rosewood with mother of pearl position markers.

Machines: Schaller Mni3, nickel plated.

Frets: 24 Dunlop 6230, medium high, medium wide, hard nickel silver.

Top: Quartersawn selected european spruce, arctop handcarved and graduated from 6mm to 2mm, tap tuned.

Back: Quartersawn flamed maple with handcarved arch graduated from 6mm to 3mm and tap tuned.

Sides: Quartersawn selected flamed maple, 2mm thick.

Binding: Multiply timber (walnut, maple and black fibre) on top, fingerboard, scratchplate, and headstock. Single ply walnut on back.

Bridge: Custom made from rosewood, height adjustable with compensated saddle. Built in Highlander piezo pickup.

Scratchplate: Quilted maple

Finish: 20 coats of 2 pack, gloss AC lacquer. Single coat of ageing toner.

Strings: CLC mandolin, bronze set, 10-37 guage.

Comments: The Highlander pickup has its pre-amp built into the body cavity
