JUAN MILLAN PERSONAL JUMBO Serial no.990104

Neck: Laminate of quartersawn mahogany and flamed maple, scarf jointed at the headstock and glued into the body. The headstock is faced with flamed walnut and bound in padauk.

Fingerboard: Selected quartersawn ebony, bound with padauk and bone nut. Scale length is 650mm. 45mm at nut

Machines: Grover Imperial, chrome.

Frets: 20 Dunlop 6230 medium high, medium width, hard nickel silver.

Top: Bookmatched yellow cedar, hand graduated (2.7mm at bridge) and tap tuned. Bound in padauk and mulitply veneers. Bracing is of quartersawn spruce scalloped for lightness and response.

Back and Sides: Bookmatched 5A quilted maple. Bound in padauk. Back bracing is quartersawn mahogany.

Bridge: Custom made ebony, ebony bridge pins, with compensated micarta saddle.

Finish: More than 20 coats of hand rubbed 2 pack, high gloss AC lacquer, a little ageing toner.

Strings: Newtone 12-52

Pickup: None.

Switching: None

Circuitry: None

Comments:. All woods specially selected for tonal quality and appearance. Flamed walnut scratchplate. This guitar is not designed for strings stronger than 13 guage.
